Jonah, the first-person narrator, wants to write a book about the end of the world - so naturally his topic is the inventor of the atomic bomb, Dr. Frank Hoenikker, and what the people surrounding him were doing on the day the bomb was dropped on Hiroshima. It is his research that leads him to Hoenikker's children, old acquaintances and, finally, on a journey that goes completely different than expected.
