The book describes the adventures of Conrad Bunger: mathematician, writer, seeker, rebel, freak. Rudy Rucker is a writer, a mathematician, and a former computer science prof. He received Philip K. Dick awards for his cyberpunk novels *Software* and *Wetware*, and an Emperor Norton award for his autobiography, *Nested Scrolls*.
