A dozen strains of malaria were injected into mental health patients and convicted criminals, including the infamous murderer Nathan Leopold. Yet after hundreds of trials and many deaths, the "magic bullet" was not found in a U.S. lab, but captured from the Nazis in battle. Still used today, chloroquine has saved more lives than any other drug in history. Mastersonwho travelled with the Malaria Unit of the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention to Tanzania to research malaria in the fielduncovers the complete story behind this dark episode, exploring the ethical perils of seeking treatments for disease while ignoring the human condition."
