This book combines the antics of cats with lighthearted limerick poetry into a colorful, educational and fun-filled reading experience. The book contains twenty-six amusing limericks written about cats. The cats are named alphabetically, starting with A for Anna and ending with Z for Zipper. Each limerick is presented with a watercolor illustration. Within each illustration is the first letter of the cat s name. For example, on the page about Anna, the young reader can search for all the A s in the illustration, count them, and check the total with the answer page. Young readers, then, gain experience in alphabet, letter recognition, and counting skills. Author Mary Jane Cogan holds a master s degree in education. She drew from her experiences as a cat lover, artist, and reading teacher to create this multifaceted book.
